## The LeMay-America's Car Museum

The spacious 165,000 square foot facility displays over 300 cars, trucks and motorcycles from private owners, corporations, and the LeMay collection.



Harold and Nancy LeMay amassed the largest privately owned collection of motor vehicles and related memorabilia in the world. At its peak, the LeMay Collection numbered in excess of 3,000 vehicles and thousands of artifacts.

The collection is broadly American and spans the 20<sup>th</sup> Century demonstrating both the dominance of the American auto industry during that period, as well as the American experience with the automobile and its impact on our culture.

The gallery showcases cars remarkable for their speed, technology and design, as well as their importance to car culture.



The building also contains gift shops, restoration shops, lecture halls, galleries, a banquet room, and a restaurant.

The LeMay's intuitively knew the power of their collection and feared that it could be lost unless they ensured that it would be preserved.

It became their dream to ensure their marvelous collection would be kept intact and housed in a beautiful museum so that everyone could enjoy these amazing vehicles and appreciate the great role that the automobile has played in American history.
